Mark your calendars for this year's Night Under the Stars--Saturday, July 21st, on the beautiful grounds of Camp Knutson. Our theme this year is "Making a Difference". Collectively, we as Camp K Volunteers, staff, counselors and donors provide an environment which enriches the lives of each kid who comes to Camp K. They depend on us in many ways--giving of our talents, friendship, time and financially through fund raising. That's why Night Under the Stars, our largest fund raising event, is so important. Each year we ask Rob Larson, Camp Knutson Director, to identify their greatest needs. At the top of their list for 2012 is a new power boat and boat lift for Camp K kids' water sports activities. Other needs include neoprene life jackets, and waterfront equipment. We hope to buy that new boat, lift and other items on the list.

There will be some exciting new things this year in response to feedback from previous years' attendees, volunteers who have worked the event and from planning meetings last fall.

- We have rented a 30' by 60' tent for the silent auction to have adequate space to display items. The wine bar, wild rice and jewelry may also be in the tent.
- Iven's on the Bay will be our caterer. There was a definite interest in switching to a local caterer.
- Since the power boat and lift are high on the list for camp, we decided to have a nautical theme (colors blue, white and gold) for decorations (dining hall and grounds), and attire for attendees---not a requirement, but encouraged! Start planning your wardrobe!
- Everyone will be able to view a list of the auction items on the Camp Knutson website before the event.
- There will be an option for online registration and purchase of tickets.
- Sponsorship of Night Under the Stars. When you buy your dinner ticket for Night Under the Stars, you become a sponsor. Sponsorship means you care about kids with special needs. It means you believe in the mission of Camp Knutson. And, it means we work together to enhance the experience of each Camp K kid, therefore "making a difference" in their lives.

There are five levels of sponsorship and each level has its own ticket price:

**ENSIGN**--\$75 per dinner ticket (regular ticket price in past years), \$50 is tax deductible.

LIEUTENANT--\$100 per dinner ticket. \$75 is tax deducible.

**COMMANDER--**\$125 per dinner ticket. \$100 is tax deductible.

**CAPTAIN--**\$150 per dinner ticket. \$125 is tax deductible.

**ADMIRAL'S TABLE**--there will be only one Admiral's table which seats 10. This table will be auctioned off on the Camp Knutson website with a beginning bid of \$2000.

There is significant work already in process for the 2012 Night Under the Stars. Committees are very energized and are committed to having this be one of our best fund raising events--and to have fun doing it! As Camp Knutson Volunteers we have the opportunity to make the week each camper spends at Camp K the highlight of their summer.

There are many ways we can help out at camp from fund raising to reading a book to a child with Downs

Syndrome to helping the counselors clean-up after one camp and prepare for the next one. The possibilities are endless. Each week one of the counselors calls me and tells me ways that they could use our help for the upcoming week. I then post these opportunities on the web site under "News". If you see something that looks interesting to you, you can call me and volunteer for that particular project. Otherwise I will call people to ask if they are available to help out.

We are asking each volunteer to fill out the Time and Talent sheet included in this newsletter. I collect all these papers and use them when I call and ask for volunteers. When you fill out the T&T sheet, please be as specific as possible. Maybe you only want to be involved in the fund raising, or maybe you only want to work with the heart camp or the skin camp and if you put that on your T&T sheet I won't call you to work if it isn't what you are interested in doing. Maybe you want to be involved in all of it which is okay too. The amount of time you spend volunteering is strictly up to you. If you can't help out when I call, no problem I know schedules get busy during the summer and things come up. I will just try you again some other time.

Please fill out the T&T sheet and then either mail it to me (my address is on the sheet) or bring it along with your calendar to the Spring Meeting on June 5th.

When you see a camper beaming or hear their laughter as they jump into camp life, you will understand the sense of satisfaction all of us volunteers experience. I am looking forward to seeing you all at camp this summer.


